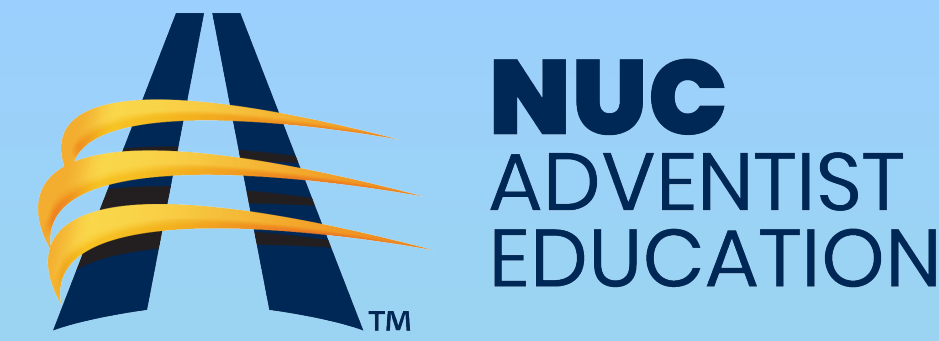
Adventist Education Mission

Characteristics of New School

- **A school with loving, dedicated, and qualified teachers (Ephesians. 4:11-16).**
- **A school with a solid curriculum, strong academics, and accurate assessment (Colossians. 3:23,24).**

A Spiritual Centered School

- **Bible Study: Encounter Curriculum, plus baptismal classes.**

School Governance

- **A Conference School supported by all the churches in the valley.**
- **The Operating Board of the school will be formed by the NUC Conference Officials, Director of Education, Pacific Union representative, school's Principal, school's Treasurer, Chair of the Parent Advisory Committee and one representative from each one of the churches in Las Vegas.**
- **A Parent Advisory Committee will be formed with the home-school leader as its chair. The function of this committee will be to support the mission and vision of the school. The home-school leader will also be a member of the School Board.**

Church Subsidy



- 1. All the churches in Las Vegas will participate in supporting the new Conference school. The subsidy will be determined by a percentage of the last three years average of tithe of each church. The churches that are already supporting Adventist Education will continue doing so. The new churches will start out at a 3% the first year, 5% on the second year, and 7% on the third year.**
